Opening of Sompo Museum of Art and Holding of Commemorative Special Exhibitions

Sompo Japan Insurance Inc. (President: Keiji Nishizawa) opened the Sompo Museum of Art on July 10, which was planned to open by the end of May, but postponed due to a state of emergency regarding the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition, the contents and session of the Commemorative Special Exhibition which was scheduled to be held at the same time as the opening of the museum will be changed.

3. Major measures to prevent infection in preparation for the opening of the museum

(1)About Entrance

For the Commemorative Special Exhibition, advanced reservation at the date and time appointed is required to ease the congestion in the museum. Please purchase ticket in advance and come to the museum. *1 *2

*2. You do not need to make a reservation for a specific date and time for the following people. However, depending on the congestion, you may have to wait for the entrance.

- ① High school students and younger (student identification)
- ② Person presenting physical disability certificate, rehabilitation certificate, or mental disability health and welfare certificate, and caregiver
- ③ Those who present the atomic bomb survivor's health handbook
- ④ Those who have advance tickets and other tickets for the Commemorative Special Exhibition.

(2)Facilities in the Building

- Staff will thoroughly check temperature and disinfect hands, and wear gloves, masks, etc.
- We regularly disinfect and clean the building, mainly in areas where there are many opportunities for fingers to touch.
- Please note that lockers are not available.
- The cafe is closed for the time being..

(3)Please cooperate with us when entering the building.

- Please wear a mask and disinfect your fingers at the entrance.
- We will check your temperature when you enter the building. We will refuse admission to visitors who have a fever of 37.5 ° C or higher as a result of temperature examination. Please refrain from coming if you have symptoms such as fever or cough, or if you are not feeling well.
- In the unlikely event that COVID-19 infection is detected by a customer or staff member, we will promptly notify you on the Sompo Museum of Art website.
