SPECIAL CLAUSE FOR INFECTION (C)

- Notwithstanding Infection Exclusion Clause and Communicable Disease Clause, the Company shall be
 liable to pay any loss of hire and/or expenses directly or indirectly caused by or contributed to by or
 arising from any infections or suspected infections which World Health Organization (WHO) declares to
 constitute a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), subject to the provisions of the
 Special Clauses for Ship Trade Disruption Insurance and this Clause specified in the Policy, provided that
 such loss occurred after the PHEIC status ceased. The Deductible and Limit of indemnity stipulated below
 shall be applied to.
- 2. Communicable Disease Clause shall not apply to the contract of insurance attaching this Special Clause.
- 3. In the event of the whole or a part of any provision of the General Clauses or other Special Clauses being inconsistent with this Special Clause, this Special Clause shall prevail.
